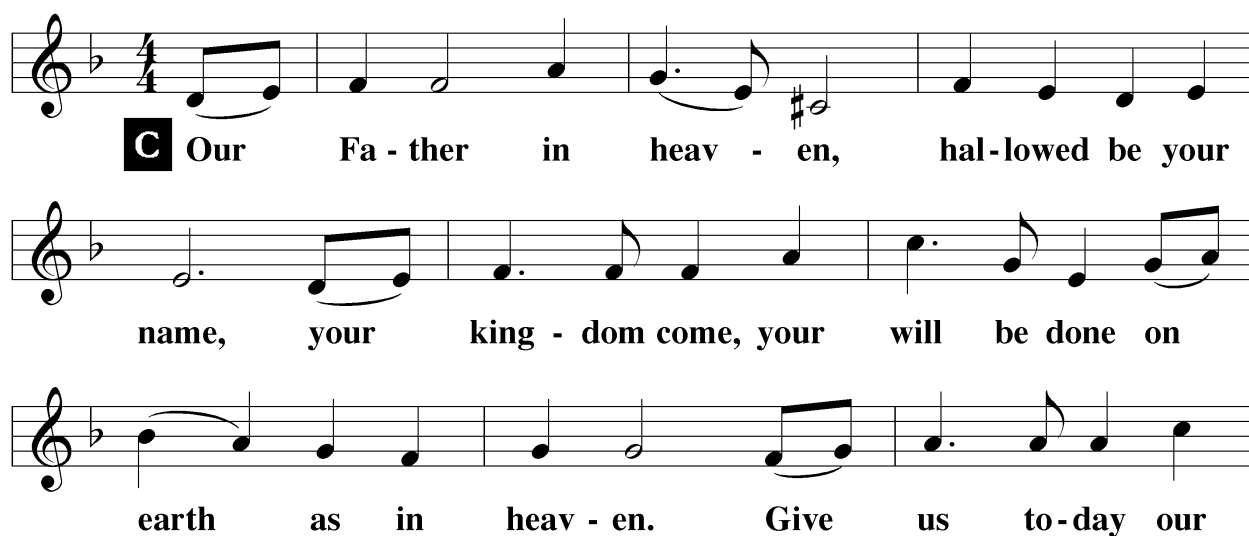
SYMBOLUM APOSTOLICUM
